shock and exposure

- Use at the first sign of illness
- Sudden onset of illness or fever
- Use immediately after an emotional shock or fright
- Ailments after exposure to cold wind
- Fear of death or great anxiety of mind
- Fever: skin is dry and hot; the face is red or pale and red alternately
- Thirst for large quantities of cold water
- Intense nervous restlessness, tossing about in agony
